Maja Slingerland has a Master's degree in tropical animal production systems (1988, with distinction) and a PhD degree in mixed crop-livestock farming systems in west Africa (2000), both at Wageningen University.

She worked for 10 years in research and development in west Africa. She initiated and coordinated large interdisciplinary research programmes: micronutrients (China, Benin, Burkina Faso); competing claims on natural resources (southern Africa, Brazil) and sustainable oil palm (Indonesia, Thailand).

She is a member of the steering committee of WU's strategic funded interdisciplinary programmes "Scaling and Governance" and "Smart and Sustainable Food production" and of two interdisciplinary research programmes on conflict and climate change of the Dutch Science Foundation. She supervises PhD and Master's studies participate in public debates and published over 100 articles and book chapters in scientific and popular journals, also she teaches a global food security course.
