Professor of Ecology, University of Cambridge

Lynn Dicks is a distinguished ecologist specializing in insect conservation and agroecology. She holds a BA Hons (First Class) in Biological Sciences from the University of Oxford and a PhD in insect community ecology from the University of Cambridge.

Currently serving as a Professor of Ecology at the University of Cambridge, where she leads the Agroecology Research Group since 2019. She also serves as a Visiting Reader at the University of East Anglia (UEA). Lynn does research in entomology, agroecology, management of biodiversity and ecosystem services on farms.

Her work bridges science and policy, advancing strategies for biodiversity conservation in food production systems.
