## ----OBJECTIVES----

To learn about the technologies available for the agronomic management and processing of the OxG hybrid developed by Cenipalma.

## SUBJECTS

Improvement, management practices (optimal harvest point), agronomic management, pests, diseases, and processing of the OxG hybrid.

## SUMMARY

The interspecific hybrid OxG is a promising cultivar due to its higher productivity, oil quality, and partial resistance to bud rot.

However, because it is a relatively new crop, many aspects of its management are unknown and may vary according to the genetic origin of the cultivars used during its development.

For this reason, in order to learn first-hand about the generalities of the OxG hybrid and the technologies available for its management, a workshop on the OxG interspecific hybrid will be held as part of the technical visits prior to the 20th INTERNATIONAL OIL PALM CONFERENCE, where different topics will be presented, including the generalities and improvement of the hybrid; nutrition management and agronomic behavior; nursery management and abnormalities; biology, phenology and optimum harvesting point in OxG hybrids; hybrid processing at the mill; and oil quality, use, and marketing.
